It gives me immense pleasure to announce an exciting virtual field trip to Calaveras, California to view and experience the Giant red wood Sequoia trees.

Park rangers and experts will walk through the park, explaining and giving our students an almost real experience of these trees, the flora and fauna of the park.

Established in 1931, Calaveras Big Trees State Park preserves two groves of giant sequoias - the world's largest trees - in the North and South Groves. The park is a mixed-conifer forest (a variety of trees living together). In addition to the giant trees, you will find the Stanislaus River, Beaver Creek, ancient volcanic formations, and natural meadows. Trails throughout the park allow you to discover the natural beauty that has awed visitors to the area since 1852.

We are excited and eager to offer this unique experience to our students of Class 5, 6,7,8.

- Students must be seated erect and not lounge on couches etc

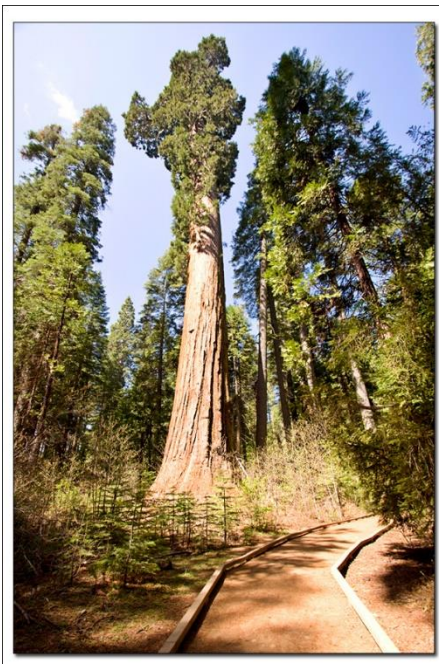
Parents who are keen to permit their wards for participation in this program must fill in the attached consent form
